Waratah's pricing is based on the market demand for its fleece and is influenced by factors such as the availability of supply and foreign currency fluctuations. All fleeces should be prepared and skirted in accordance with the Waratah Fleece Preparation Manual. Fleece is classed, baled and valued by AWEX stencilled classers using the AAA classing Code of Practice.
